### GOOD NEWS DAY

Today is a good news day because of that day 2000 years ago when the angels brought good news to the SHEPHERDS. Let's remind ourselves of the words again: *"Don't be afraid! I am here with good news for you, which will bring great joy to all the people. This very day in David's town your Saviour was born--Christ the Lord!"*

God was giving the human race a gift – His Son. GOOD NEWS But the gift wasn't a baby, it was the man that the baby grew into. Why did God give His Son to the world? Here's my favourite Christmas verse again: JOHN 3:16 *For God so loved the world that He gave us His only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

That's the real good news of Christmas, the God loved each of us so much that He sent His only Son because He wanted us all to receive another gift - eternal life - knowing God for the whole of eternity. Jesus died so that all the things that separate us from God - the things that we do wrong that keep us from God, our sins - can be forgiven and God can offer us life eternally with Him.

What sorts of things separate us from God? - things that are wrong - that we know are wrong, ignoring God, doing our thing, guilt, resentment, anger. Jesus died so that we could find a way open to God, if we are prepared to believe Him, trust Him, follow Him.

If you've never done that then take the opportunity to receive the greatest Christmas present you've ever had - God Himself, to know His presence with you now and have a hope of eternal life for the future.

My Lord and my God.  
I have lived life my way.  
I have done many wrong things.  
I turn away from all my sin.  
Please forgive me.  
Lord Jesus, I trust you now to be my Lord and my Saviour.  
Thank You for dying in my place.  
I ask You now for Your gift of eternal life.  
I give my life to You and want You to be my Lord.  
Help me to live for You by the power of Your Holy Spirit.  
These things I pray in Jesus' name.  
Amen

If we already trust and follow Jesus then today is a reminder to us that we have much to rejoice and worship God for. Let's give God thanks for that gift of life we've received and share it with others as we celebrate this Christmas time!
